

Hebron Church in Novosibirsk, Siberia?

What? Yes, your love for connecting others with Jesus Christ and His lifestyle has resulted in the birth of Hebron Church in Novosibirsk, Siberia.

In 1989, Joe Wilson accepted Jesus Christ as his savior at Hebron Church of Dacula, Georgia and grew here in faith and in passion for missions. He and his wife Alesia and family are now serving as Church Planters in Novosibirsk, mentoring men, evangelizing and starting Networks of Reproducing Churches.

Andre Belozorov, Pastor of Novosibirsk Bible Church (NBC), one of the churches planted in Novosibirsk, caught a vision for ministry at a rehab center where one of his members serves as Director. Around twenty men live at the rehab center at any given time, and most of them receive visits from family and friends on Sundays. This opens up an opportunity to reach them with the love of Christ, as Joe says, “at a time when they are sensitive to the Lord’s work in their lives.” New housing developments in the area also create a harvest field for Christ. Thus, Hebron Church of Novosibirsk was born as an outreach of NBC at the rehab center.

Hebron Church of Dacula sent Duke Forster, Judy Gordon and Denise Kitchen about a year ago to train and implement the Celebrate Recovery ministry in Novosibirsk, and have become partners in this new ministry. NBC is only a year old, so we celebrate their contagious passion for Christ which has already borne fruit!

The Wilsons are now starting a new Church in Divnigorsk which will be part of the already established Krasnoyarsk Network of Churches. This will be the 17th Church that has been started in Belarus and the Siberia region of Russia. Pray for them as they continue to serve in Christ’s name and as an extension of your obedience to God’s Word!
